

At the same time as the **amendments** to the Tobacco Law, Cabinet Regulations No. 440, titled "The Procedure fo Providing and Processing Information on Tobacco Products, Tobacco Substitute Products, Herbal Smoking Products, Electronic Cigarettes, and Their Refill Containers"

came into force on August 1, 2024

TOBACCO PRODUCTS accompanied by a package unit image file in PDF format submitted for placing on the market after August 1, 2024

- The relevant product type must be submitted (Annex VI)
- **For Novel Tobacco Products:** six months before placing it on the market tobacco products, submit detailed information
 - Toxicological data regarding the ingredients in both burned and unburned forms must be included, detailing their impacts on consumer health and addictive characteristics, in accordance with the specified format (Annex IV).

For cigarettes, roll-your-own (RYO) tobacco, and novel tobacco products (NTP), any characteristic flavor other than tobacco is prohibited.


A clear image of the packaging unit must be attached. The photograph should be sufficiently detailed to facilitate the identification of distinct product presentations

Herbal ingredients are specified by the Latin name of the plant, the part of the plant utilized, and the form of preparation (crushed drug, extract, essential oil, powder, etc.)

E-CIGARETTES

E-CIGARETTES AND REFILLS submitted for placing on the market after January 1, 2025

- ! The relevant product type must be specified (Annex VI)
- A certificate from an accredited laboratory and a test report must be included.
 - 1.1. regarding the quantitative and qualitative aspects of emissions measured in mass units
 - 1.2. regarding the nicotine emitted by the electronic cigarette in consistent quantities
- under typical usage conditions

When a new presentation (brand) is added to an existing product, a confirmation form must be attached (Annex V)

Upon request:

- product illustration featuring model, brand, dimensions, and specifications
- photofixations utilizing a ruler or caliper, at two angles
- The data processing fee for each new presentation (brand) added to an existing product is



TOBACCO SUBSTITUTE PRODUCTS

submitted for placing on the market after January 1, 2025



Tobacco substitute products reported to the Health Inspectorate between August 1, 2024, and September 1, 2024, may be marketed starting January 1, 2025

Preliminary information processing fee – 125.50 EUR Fee for data processing for each additional new presentation (brand) added to an existing product – 125.50 EUR Annual information processing fee – 78.49 EUR



What is the procedure for processing information submitted via EU-CEG?

The submitters provides

information via EU-CEG

- The Inspectorate receives an e-mail with a request for payment of the ID: submitted via EU-CEG
- The Inspectorate inform new **EU-CEG** submitters regarding the payment and fee amount

Information is processed in the order of application review

Ensures the EU-CEG ID and sends an invoice for the requested IDs to the specified email address

Following payment receiving, an deeper analysis of the submitted information is conducted

Inconsistencies have been found (______ (Section 3 of the Tobacco Law)
